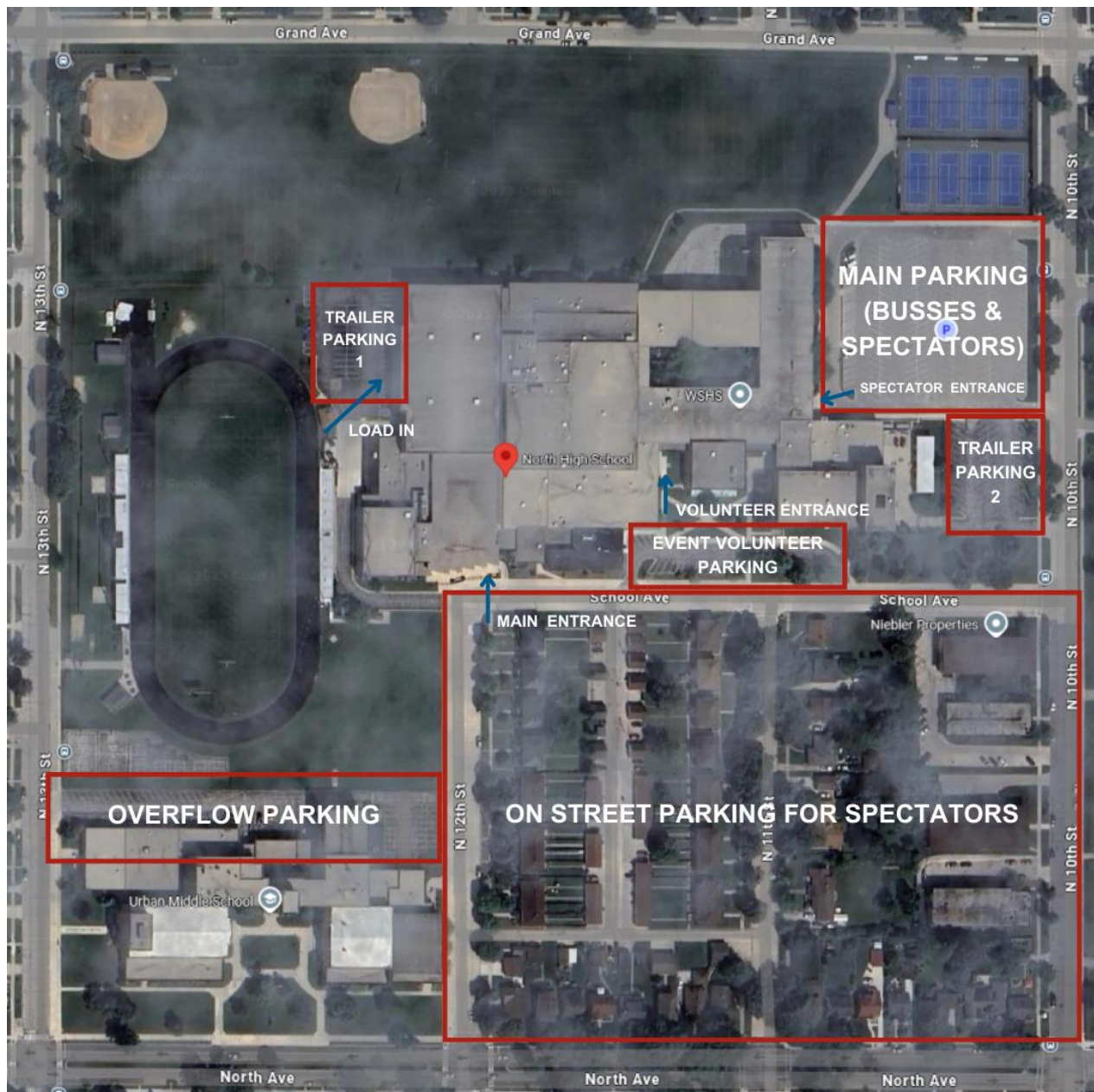

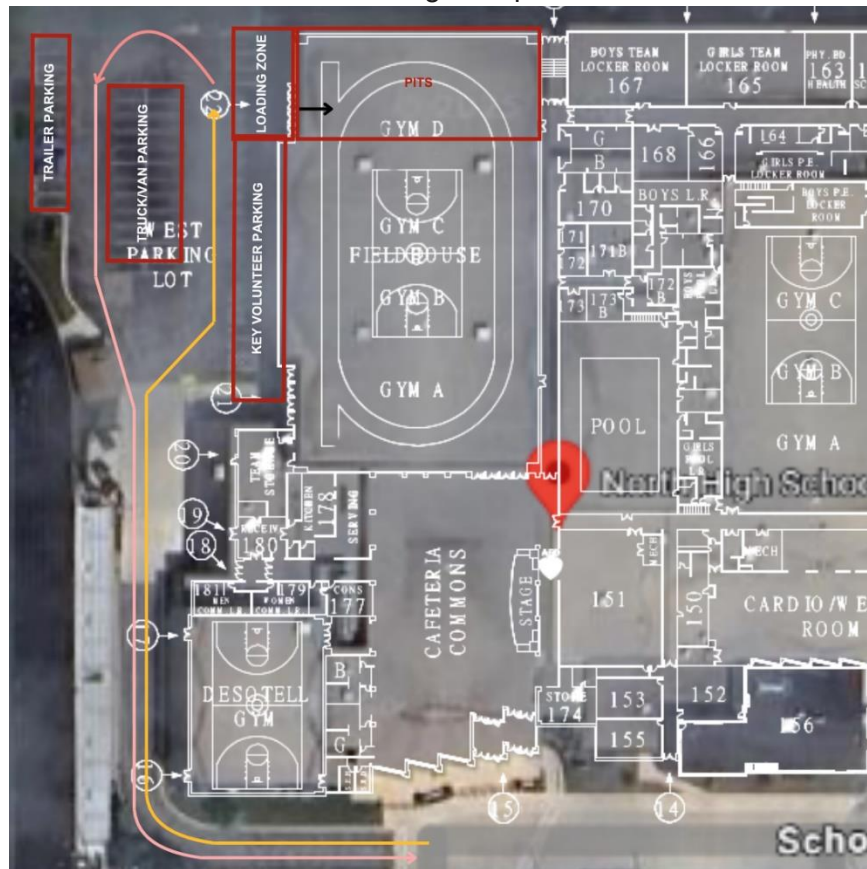
Parking



Load-In/ Load- Out

- Load-In

- Load in will happen from School Avenue for teams. Please consider using North 10th Street to turn onto School Avenue if you are pulling a trailer. This will give you a straight path (rather than taking North 12th street) into the loading lot.
- Teams may choose to park smaller trailers in the west lot after loading OR to put them in the East Lot near the Tech Ed Garages. These spaces are on the south end of that lot. Door 22 is the load in set of doors. If you need a larger garage door to load in, that is located at Door 20.
- Traffic will be monitored and directed for load in starting at School Avenue. Teams leaving vehicles overnight may park in the West lot.
- Buses must park in the East Lot off of N 10 Street and students may either enter the building at Door 3 from the East lot or Door 15 on School Avenue.
- Parents/attendees/families are encouraged to park in the East Lot and enter door 3 or door 15.

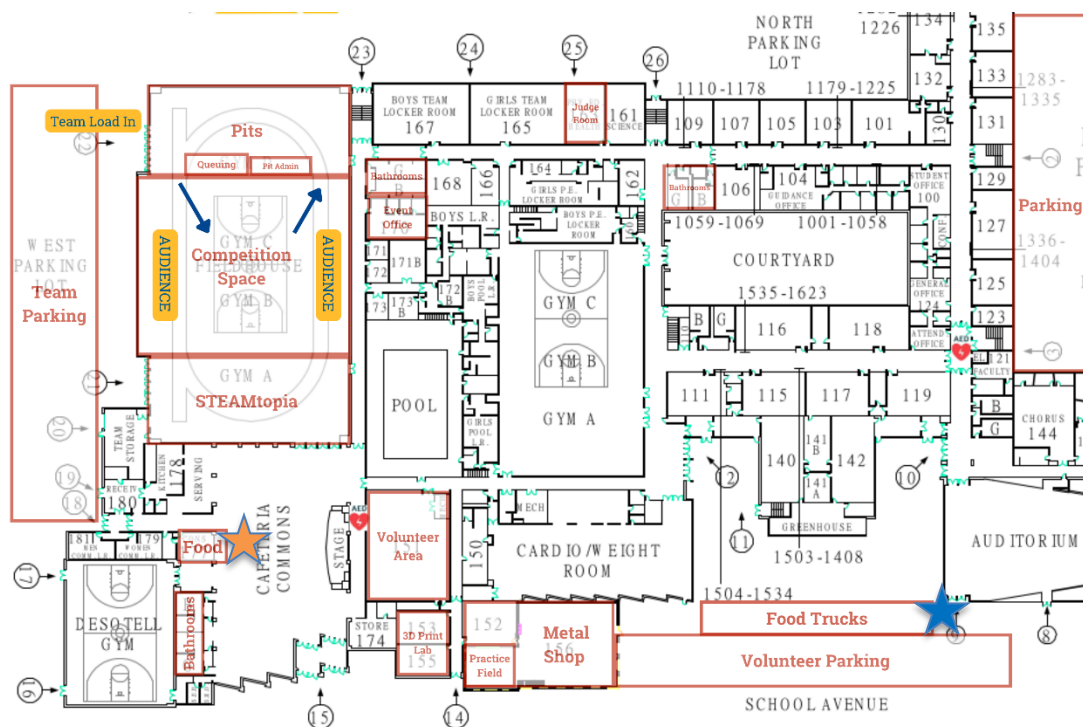

Awards Overview

We're excited to recognize team achievements and individual contributions through a variety of Judged Awards at this event. Awards fall into two categories: Pit-Interviewed Awards and Submitted Awards.

Pit-Interviewed Awards

These awards will be determined based on interviews conducted with teams in their pits:

- **Programming Award** (i.e. Innovation in Control / Autonomous)
Celebrates the team that has demonstrated a professional approach to the software design process with reliable, high-performance autonomous robot operation, the ability to position itself and execute tasks; and an innovative control system or application of control components to provide unique machine functions.
- **Engineering Design Award** (i.e. Industrial Design / Engineering Excellence)
Celebrates a professional approach to the design process; intentional creativity that enhances play strategy; A balance between form, function, and aesthetics; or machine robustness in concept and fabrication.
- **Business Excellence Award** (i.e Team Sustainability/Imagery)
Recognizes a team that expresses an entrepreneurial spirit, a comprehensive business plan to define, manage and achieve the team's ongoing objectives, or they have established a recognizable social media presence in which they foster unity between the team, their sponsors and the broader community.
- **Breakthrough Award** (i.e. Rising All-Star)
Recognizes a team that persevered through any challenge that the 2024-2025 season threw at them and rose to the FIRST Core Values in the face of obstacles. The team environment has fostered growth of both the individuals and the team as a whole.
- **Judges Award**
A team that the judging panel identified as having contributions both on and off the field, success during competition, or team community that deserved acknowledgement.
- **Rookie Sensation** (i.e. Rookie All-star)
Recognizes a 2024-2025 rookie team that took the FIRST mission to heart and embodies the FIRST ethos. This team has already made significant progress to find a balance between the technical and non-technical aspects of a team.
